It took a long time, but Dan is doing really well now. Daniel lives at BDC because he receives wonderful care and he feels that it is his home. I would not dream of moving him from BDC, but I also want my son to know that he will always be an important part of my life. My solution is to visit with him for a week, approximately every six weeks. Without The Danielle House, this would not be possible.

Diane, Mary Lou, Pat & Vin, and all the wonderful volunteers make The Danielle House a warm, welcoming haven for people in need, whether they be family members and caregivers of someone who is hospitalized, people who are receiving treatments themselves, or repeat visitors like me. Such examples are Mohammed, a child from Iran who was in Binghamton for facial surgery, a senior couple who had lost their home in the flood of 2007, and a young couple who recently had twins and needed to be near Lourdes Hospital. 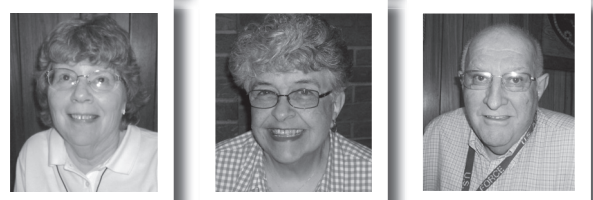

Little did we know that when we said goodbye, it would be for the last time. Rick passed away about three weeks after he left The Danielle House due to complications from his illness.

Rick's sister writes:

Thank you so much for all your kind words about Rick. My family (Rick's family) is so thrilled to know that much of his last few months of life were spent with people who cared so much for him. As you learned from your short time with him, Rick had a certain charisma and everyone just loved him. We have received countless cards and messages from people that he knew and we are not surprised by the impact he had.

While we "had" Rick for 59 years, you spent only a few months with him. He actually spent more time with you in what, unbeknownst to us, were his last few months of life than he spent with his "family." It gives us a great sense of peace that Rick found in The Danielle House not just a place to stay, but a family who loved him. For that, our family is, forever, in your debt.
